Introduction

- New focus on administrative & linked datasets
- Establishing more partnerships with other federal government departments, provincial governments and institutions
- Incorporating researchers' needs, facilitating custom requests when possible
- Consequently, the administrative and linked data holdings have been increasing exponentially since 2015

What is an administrative dataset?

Advantages:

- Not a survey... not a census
- Has information on the whole population that is covered → Not a sample!
- More accurate than self-reported figures (e.g. income, hospital visits, immigration status & type, social assistance recipients, etc.)

Challenges:

- Not structured as well as Statistics Canada's own datasets
 - Data collection is generally not for the sake of statistical analysis
 - Requires more prep time to understand and clean the data
 - Documentations can be scarce
